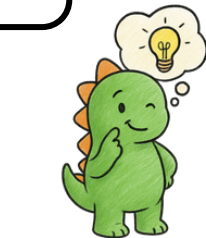


Option 2: Full Story

Falling Action:

Show how the characters try to solve the problem and what happens next.



Pages 10-11 →

Ending:

Show how everything finishes and how the characters feel.
